Here are a few points that may be helpful to you in planning your trip's details:

1. Firstly, we hope your travel to and from Athens goes smoothly.
The airport is about a 40-minute drive from the city center; commuting from and to the airport should be easy by metro/suburban train, by public bus, or private transportation (Uber, Taxi).
2. The Conference is held at our Agia Paraskevi campus, 6 Gravias street, 153 42.

3. For commuting within Athens, you can use the public transport network and local taxis (UBER & FREENOW). Additional information about what to visit and prepare in the advance for our beautiful city can be found below.
4. The weather in Athens in June is quite warm. Average temperature during June is around 27-30 degrees Celsius, although this could change.
5. Please do not forget to bring your presentation on a USB stick and load on to the computer in advance of your session. We recommend the PDF format to avoid any compatibility issues.
6. The Conference programme will be available in print for you to collect but please note that there may have been some minor changes. The file on the conference website will be the latest version for your information.

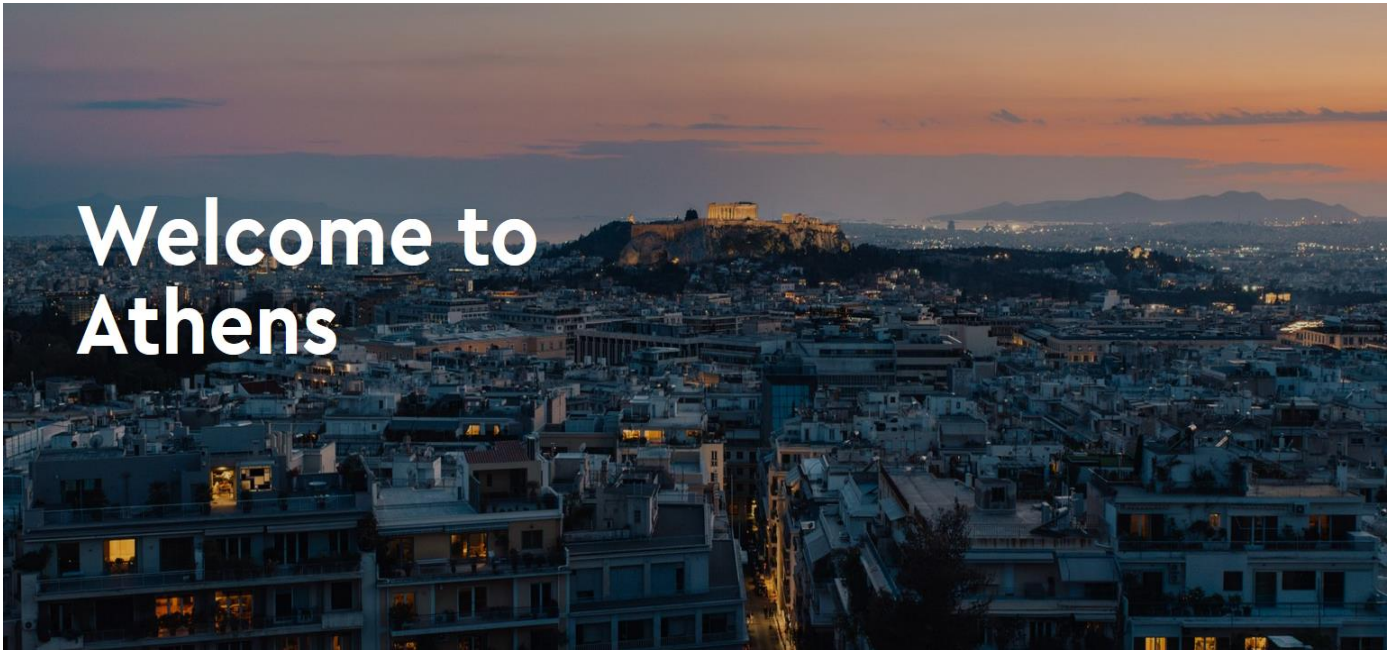

Get to Deree – The American College of Greece

From the Airport

Take the **Suburban Railway** (direction Ano Liosia) from airport to **Plakentias station** and then **Bus 406**, Plakentias to 9th Station of Aghia Paraskevi.

For respective timetables, please check the website of TRAINOSE SA. www.trainose.gr and OASA – Athens Urban Transport, www.oasa.gr .

By Public Transportation

You can reach the campus by using the Metro system (blue line No. 3) to **Nomismatokopio Station**.

From there, bus lines **B5, 406 & 407** will take you to Aghiou Ioannou Square, an, approximately, 5-minute walk (300 meters) to Deree – The American College of Greece Central Gate.

By Car

You can reach the campus using Attica motorway A62, E 94/A6, Hymettus Ring Road, A64, Exit Y3.

Transportation to/from Deree from/to Nomismatokopio

A bus shuttle will be available daily to pick you up from Nomismatokopio Station to Deree and back; *pickup schedule TBA.*

Registration

All participants should register at the Registration Desk located in the Main Corridor of Deree – The American College of Greece. With registration, delegates will be provided with a bag containing the printed program and various conference materials.

Presentation and discussions

A desktop PC / laptop and a projector is available in each conference room. Please bring your USB memory stick and upload your presentation or discussion (in PowerPoint or PDF) during the break before your session is due to start.

Discussants' responsibility

To serve the needs of authors presenting at the EFMA 2025 conference, discussants are kindly requested to hand out to the authors and the session chair their written comments prior to or after the particular session. Please check the full program for your schedule as a discussant.

Timing of presentations

Each paper has 35-minute slot which should be broken down as follows: 20 minutes for the author, 10 minutes for the discussant and 5 minutes for questions and answers from the floor.
