HOW TO USE THE CONFERENCE MANAGEMENT TOOL

1. Follow the URL <https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/WINTERSCHOOL2020> and create account. OR, in the "All Conferences" list, search for: "TAPMI-MAX PLANCK-CHINESE ACADEMY WINTER SCHOOL ON BOUNDED RATIONALITY 2020" and click on the link.

HOW TO SUBMIT APPLICATION

- Upload the following:
 - Your CV
 - A statement of interest that explains the following questions (maximum 800-1000 words)
 - How you (and your research) would benefit from participation?
 - How your research fits the overall theme/topic?
 - How you would contribute to the winter school?
 - Personal Details:
 - Demographic details (Name, Age, and City of Travel)
 - Highest degree (Post-doc, Ph.D., Masters)
 - Field of study
 - Name of Ph.D. supervisor
 - University
 - One short letter of recommendation, sent by separate e-mail by your referee to winterschool@tapmi.edu.in with the subject heading Winter School Recommendation Letter for "Firstname Lastname".
